

# Paper Doll Militia Covid19 policies

Retreats 2023 / Updated August 2022

## Vaccination Policies

We highly encourage all participants to be vaccinated against Covid19 with all recommended booster shots, We also allow participants to attend the Greece retreat if they are unvaccinated AND have had a prior covid19 infection. (documentation will be verified) Unvaccinated people may be subject to stricter covid19 policies including but not limited to registering for a private room and more frequent testing.

## Testing

Testing for covid19 is one of our primary tools for covid19 prevention. Regardless of your vaccination status, we ask that everyone test before traveling. PCR tests are preferred, but if availability is limited, we will accept a rapid test. Paper Doll Militia will provide two antigen tests for each participant, one on arrival and one to be taken on day 5. All attendees will be given an at-home antigen test upon arrival and if any symptoms arise during the retreat.

## PPE while traveling

We strongly encourage ALL participants, regardless of vaccination, wear protective PPE while traveling, to help avoid bringing covid19 into the retreat. N95 or KN94 masks are highly encouraged. Take care of the group by taking the extra step to ensure we all have a healthy and covid-free adventure.

We realize that this request may be stricter than some government regulations, but it is one of the most effective ways that we can avoid contracting the virus while traveling, and avoid bringing it into the shared housing at the retreat. A positive covid case (or many) would have a huge impact on our ability to provide everyone with the full retreat experience, so we want to protect the bubble as much as possible. Additionally, please refrain from any high risk activities in the week leading up to the retreat.

## Our Ethical Responsibility to the Locations We Visit

Part of our Covid19 policies have to do with protecting the individuals in the local communities that we are visiting. When we are in the accommodations of the retreat participants will essentially be in a pod, and will not need to wear masks with one another. However when leaving the accommodation, and entering into a public domain, we will be following the local regulations and restrictions of the area at that time.

## Experiencing symptoms and/or positive test during a retreat

If a retreator begins to experience symptoms of COVID before or during the retreat, they will be required to get tested immediately and put in isolation for a minimum of 5 days. If this occurs, extra financial investment may incur at the resident's expense for isolation housing, medical, and/or transportation expenses. Paper Doll Militia is not financially responsible for paying for alternative housing or medical expenses. We recommend you do diligent research on travel and health insurance to help cover costs if that becomes necessary. Paper Doll Militia staff will do everything in our power to take care of the retreator. The retreator may be able to rejoin the group after 5 days of isolation and with a negative PCR test.

## Updating our Policies

We are closely following the release of new data, and we will be updating our policies to reflect the recommendations from public health experts. There is a chance that our policies may loosen before the date of the retreat, however, when you are registering please only register based on the current policies in place.
